



Frequently Asked Questions for HGSS Open Event - October 2022

GCSE Exam Results:

- 85% of students achieved grades 9-4 in English
- 79% of students achieved grades 9-4 in Maths
- 68% of students achieved 5 or more GCSE grades at 9-4 including Maths and English
- 28% of grades were 9-7
- 67 grades were the top '9' grade

Examples of Star performing students:

- Student A: 9x9, 1x7
- Students B: 9x9, 1x8, 1x7
- Student C: 6x9, 4x8

A-Level 2022 Results:

- 25% of grades were A*-A
- 63% of grades were A*-B
- 80% of grades were A*-C
- 100% of students who applied through UCAS or for an apprenticeship received a place at university or on their Apprenticeship.
- University and Apprenticeship destinations included Exeter, Nottingham, Southampton, Birmingham, York, King's and Deloitte.

Other FAQs:

- Homework is published on 'Satchel' and parents receive notifications from the app. Year 7 start with just English and Maths homework for the first two weeks. Support is available in the Library after school.
- Setting is used effectively in a range of subjects to best support all students, including English, Maths and Science from Year 7.
- High Prior Attaining Students access activities, such as: Model UN Conference; challenging work in class; UK Maths Challenge; UCAS support; Brilliant Club, etc.
- We achieve high standards because we have high expectations. Parents support our firm lines, and we have whole school systems for helping students behave well. We are firm and fair.
- Getting a place, HGSS has been oversubscribed for the last three years. The key is to make HGSS first choice. There is nothing to be gained by only putting one school down. We maintain a waiting list for places if you are unsuccessful initially.
