Our Learning Support Department caters for a variety of needs including but not limited to Speech Language and Communication need (SLCN), Autistic Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Specific Learning Difficulties (SpLD). There is a specialism for Speech Language and Communication needs in our Additionally Resourced Provision (ARP) where we have a Speech and Language Therapist and a Speech and Language Therapist Assistant on site.

At HGSS we believe that your child's learning needs will first be met through the high-quality teaching delivered by the class teacher. Regular professional development ensures that staff at HGSS are fully aware of how to cater for a range of Special Educational Needs. The Learning Support Department is in regular communication with teaching staff to make sure that everyone is aware of what Special Educational needs there are within the school, and how to help support those needs in the classroom.
