RE: Drama production - 2 October 2018

Children across the UK are spending increasing amounts of time on the internet, and at younger ages. Although this brings many opportunities to enjoy themselves and learn, it also brings potential risks.

Buckinghamshire County Council is very lucky to have been awarded money, as part of the Cybercrime grant from the Thames Valley Police and Crime Commissioner, to help children stay safe online.

Buckinghamshire have commissioned school drama specialists AlterEgo Creative Solutions (creators of Chelsea's Choice) to provide a play suitable for children in Year 7. It will help them learn about online risk and healthy online behaviour and relationships.

The play will be visiting 40 schools in Buckinghamshire and our school has secured a performance so that your child can benefit from this opportunity. The play will be visiting our school on 2 October 2018.

The play is age appropriate and is called "Click". It lasts approximately 45 minutes and will cover issues such as online safety, cyberbullying and good online communication. Our school will be doing follow up work to ensure that children get the maximum benefit from the play and it will be an important part of our online safety curriculum. As a follow up to the play, the children will also take part in a short, anonymous, opinion survey to measure the impact of the performance.

We hope that this will be a memorable way to enhance their safe internet usage and help our children to stay safe on line.

We would welcome your support to maximise your child's benefit from the performance. We know that you already take time to ensure your children know how to keep safe on the internet. Talking to your child about the play and what they have learnt would be a great way to support this learning.

Cashless catering with sQuid

At Holmer Green we use a cashless card system for paying for food in our Canteen. This means:-

- Less queuing and more break time
- No need to carry cash to school
- Protection of the card balance should it be lost or stolen

The card costs $\pounds 2.50$ and all you need to do is logon to the SchoolComms payment system and order the card. The cards will be issued by sQuid and will come home via your child. You will then you will be able to top the card up online. The on screen instructions are clear and easy to follow.

This facility is also be available for students who claim Free School Meals and will avoid any distinction with other students. Free School Meals cards will be paid for and ordered by the school.

Once you have created a sQuid account and registered the card you will also be able to manage your sQuid account online at anytime to:

- Check your child's account balance and view their transactions
- Top up your child's sQuid account from your bank account, credit or debit card
- Update their details and preferences

We are currently accepting cash in the Canteen but from 1 October we will only be accepting card payments so please make sure you order your card at your earliest convenience.
