

## **A-Level Business / Economics**

Pre-course task to be completed by first day in school, ie 6<sup>th</sup> September, 2022.

You need to complete a self-contained task that will be used to demonstrate not only your aptitude for studying this subject, but also how you are becoming not only a student but a scholar of this field, beyond the specification. The task below gives you lots of opportunity to direct your own research and produce a rich and interesting outcome. You should spend at least three hours completing this task, and should be mindful that it will, in part, form the basis of the first 'attitude to learning' report grade that you will receive early in the Autumn term.

## Task: Create your Business/Economics A level news tracker

Select articles about current UK business and/or economic issues,

- You have been directed to useful sources from QUALITY news outlets.
- Print the article (or cut from a newspaper!) Stick it in a scrapbook, you will be
  expected to update this throughout the course. For your news tracker, you can use a
  scrapbook or a small ring binder.
- Highlight the key vocab in the article and note /explain /expand on sections you think are important and do a small spider / flow diagram linking the content to what you think are the key business or economics issues from the piece.
- Say why you found this interesting.

You should have a minimum of 4 articles, try and cover national issues, individual markets or firms. NB there will be questions in your exam papers that use real news from the few years before the exam - having your own news tracker will prepare you for this.
